

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that on January 5, 2026, a public hearing, which may be continued or adjourned, will be held by the Ohio Higher Educational Facility Commission at 25 South Front Street, Second Floor, Columbus, Ohio commencing at 9:00 a.m. local time with respect to the proposed issuance by the Ohio Higher Educational Facility Commission (the “Issuer”) of State of Ohio Higher Educational Facility Revenue Bonds (Wittenberg University 2026 Project) (the “Bonds”) in an aggregate principal face amount not to exceed \$66,000,000 in one or more series, pursuant to Chapter 3377 and Sections 9.98 through 9.983, Ohio Revised Code, as amended (collectively, the “Act”), in connection with a plan of finance for the benefit The Board of Directors of Wittenberg College, an Ohio nonprofit corporation, acting for and on behalf of Wittenberg University (collectively, the “University”). The Bonds will be issued as qualified 501(c)(3) bonds under Section 145 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the proceeds of the Bonds will be used to finance and refinance the costs of acquiring, constructing, equipping, furnishing, installing and otherwise improving “educational facilities” (as defined in the Act, “Educational Facilities”) of the University.

The proceeds of the Bonds will be made available to the University to finance and refinance the costs of the Educational Facilities located on or in close proximity to the University’s main campus, the administrative offices of which are located at 3 West Campus Drive, Springfield, Ohio 45504.

The initial legal owner and principal user of the Educational Facilities financed and refinanced by the Bonds is the University.

The Bonds will be special obligations of the Issuer and will not constitute a debt or a pledge of the faith and credit or the taxing power of the Issuer or the State of Ohio.

Persons wishing to express their views on the proposed Bonds may appear at the hearing or submit their views in writing regarding the proposed Bonds and the location and nature of the Educational Facilities to be financed and refinanced.
